## You Can Scoop Up a Pair of Vintage Cottages in L.A. for \$1.1M

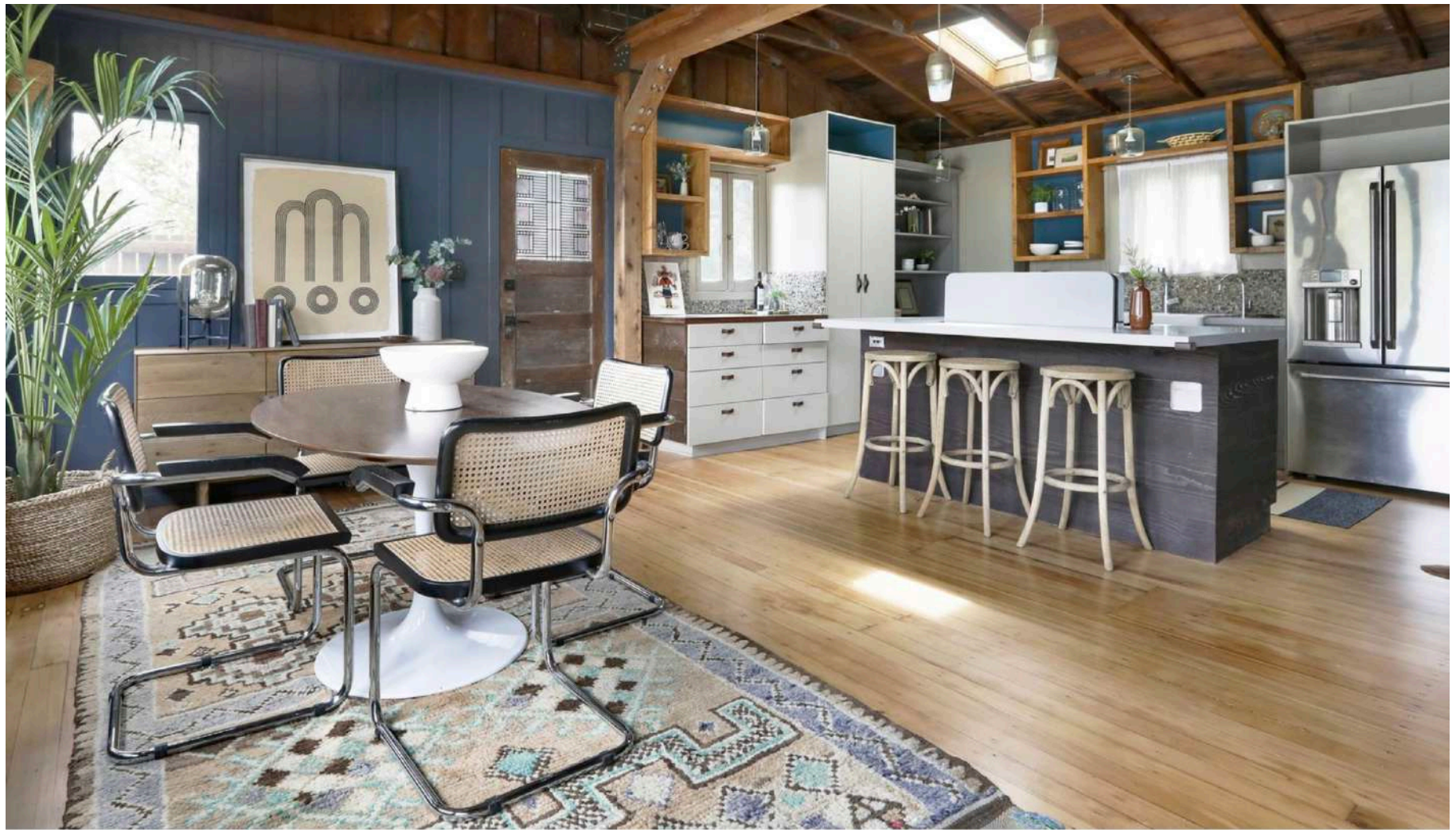

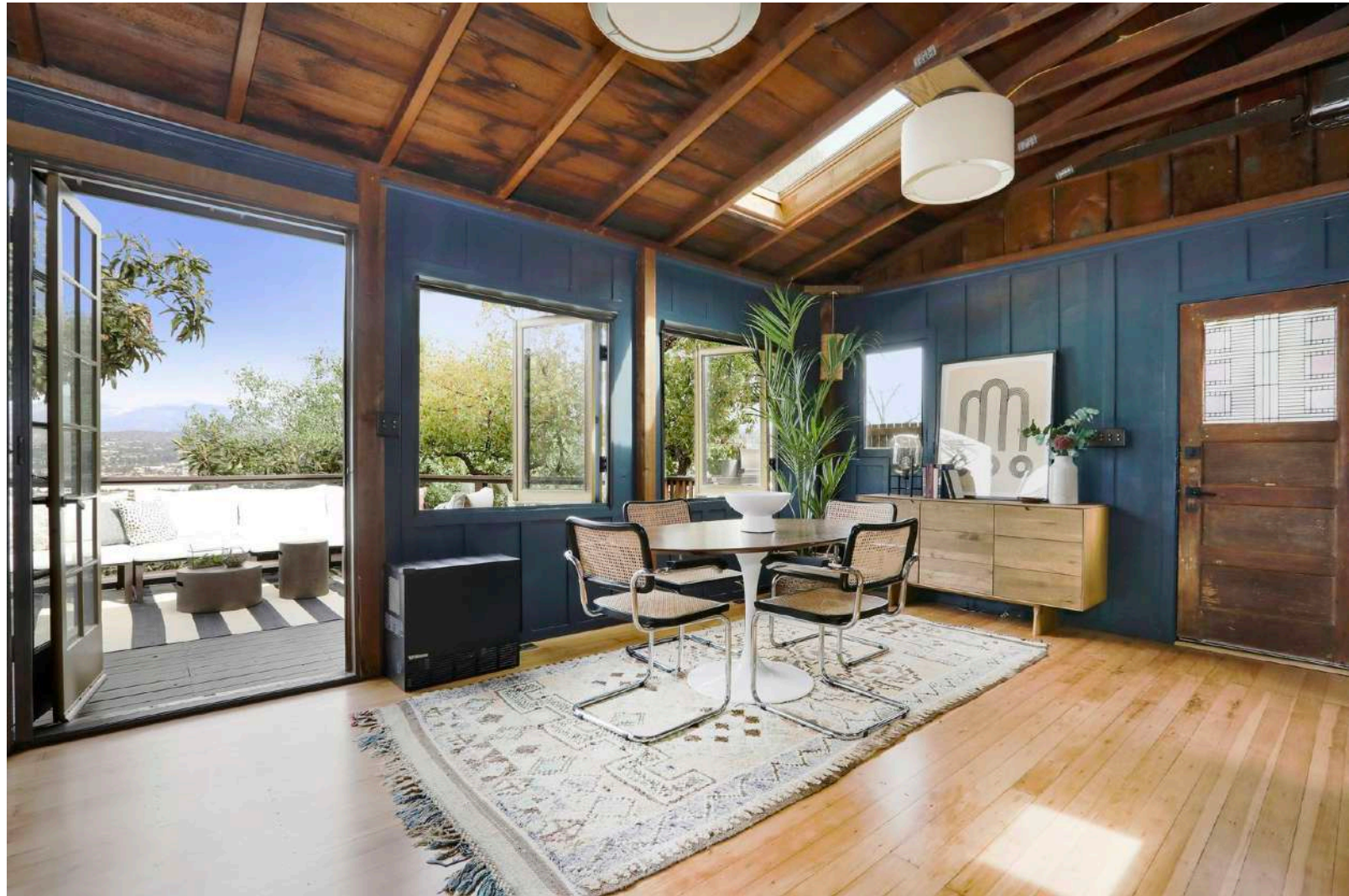

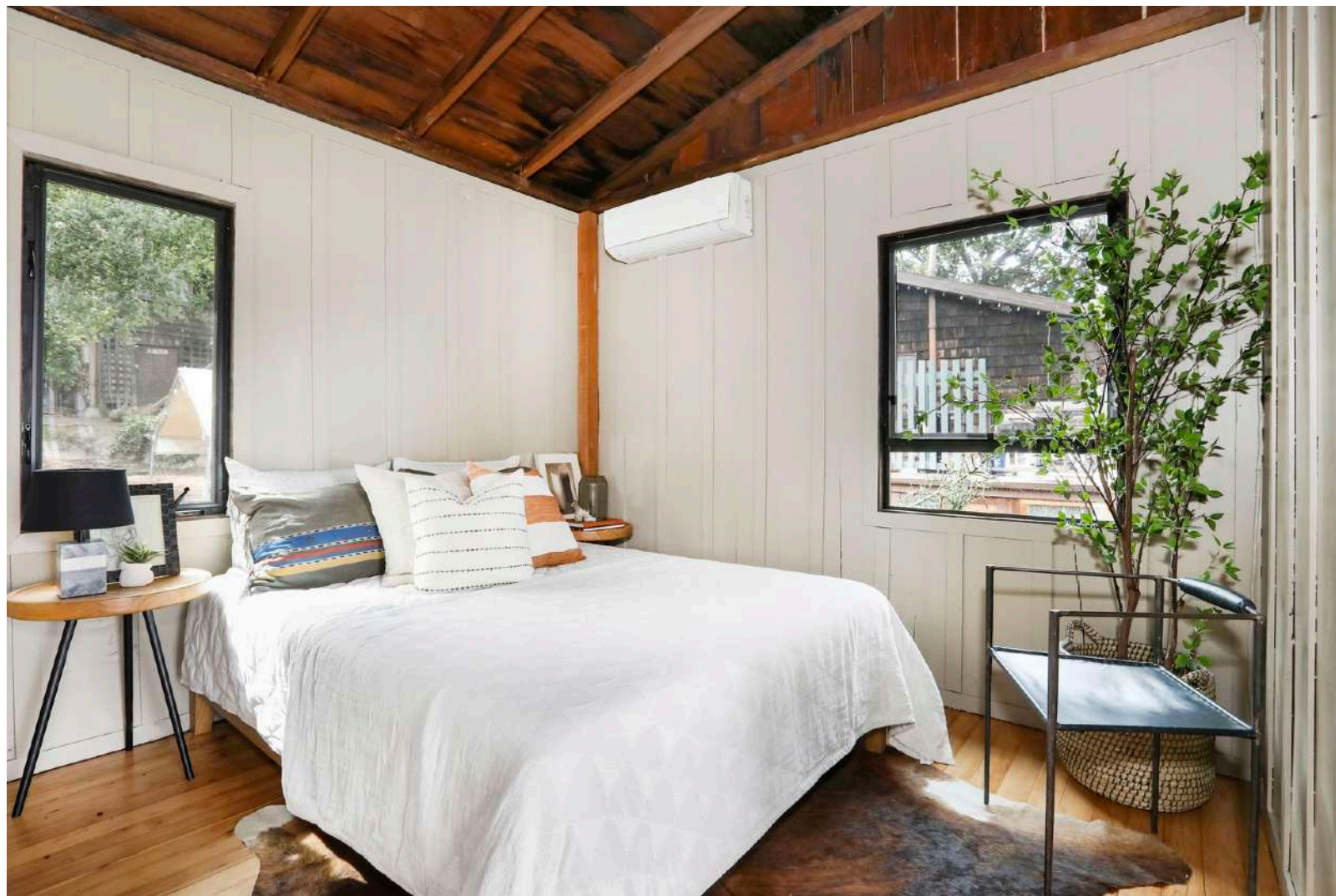


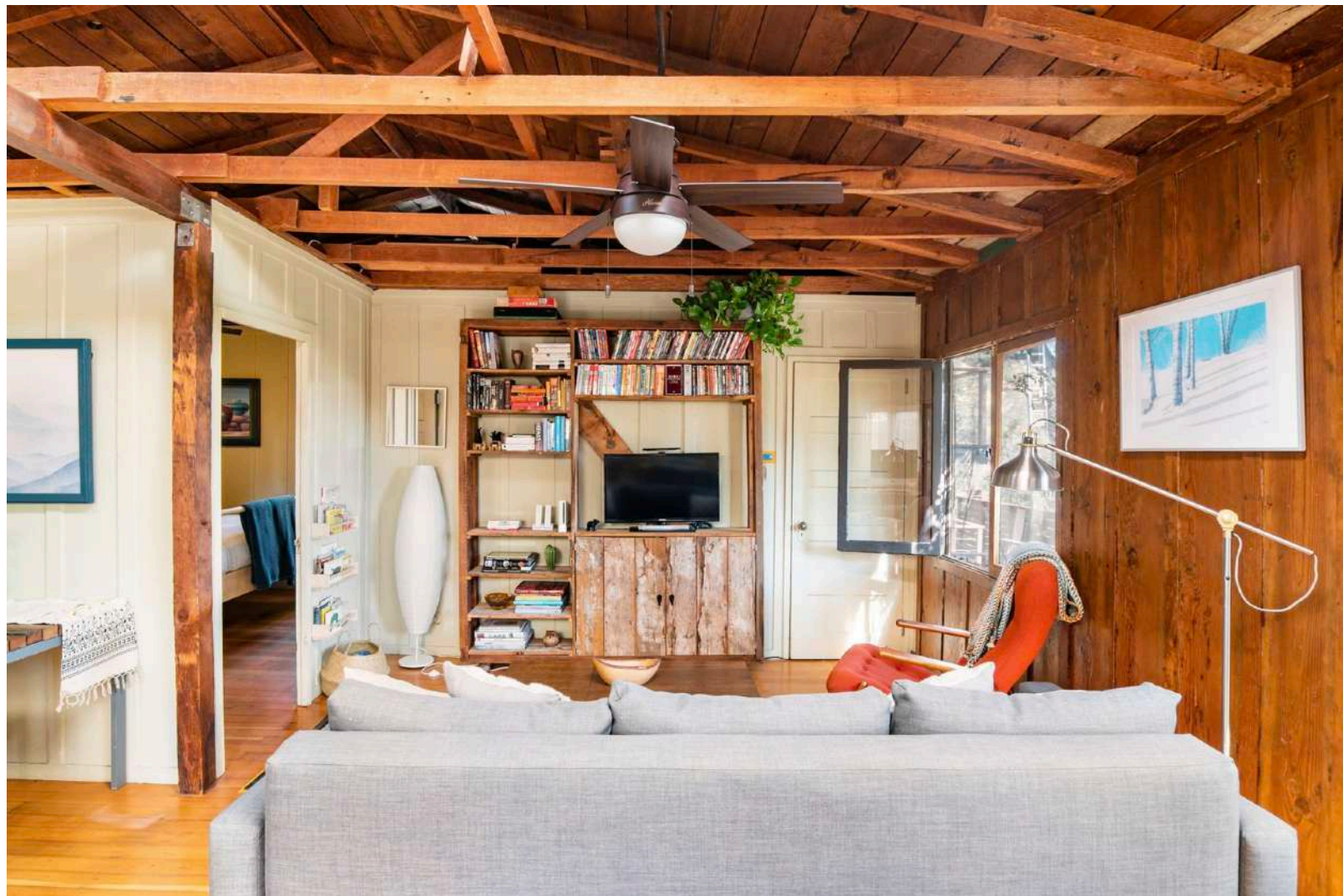




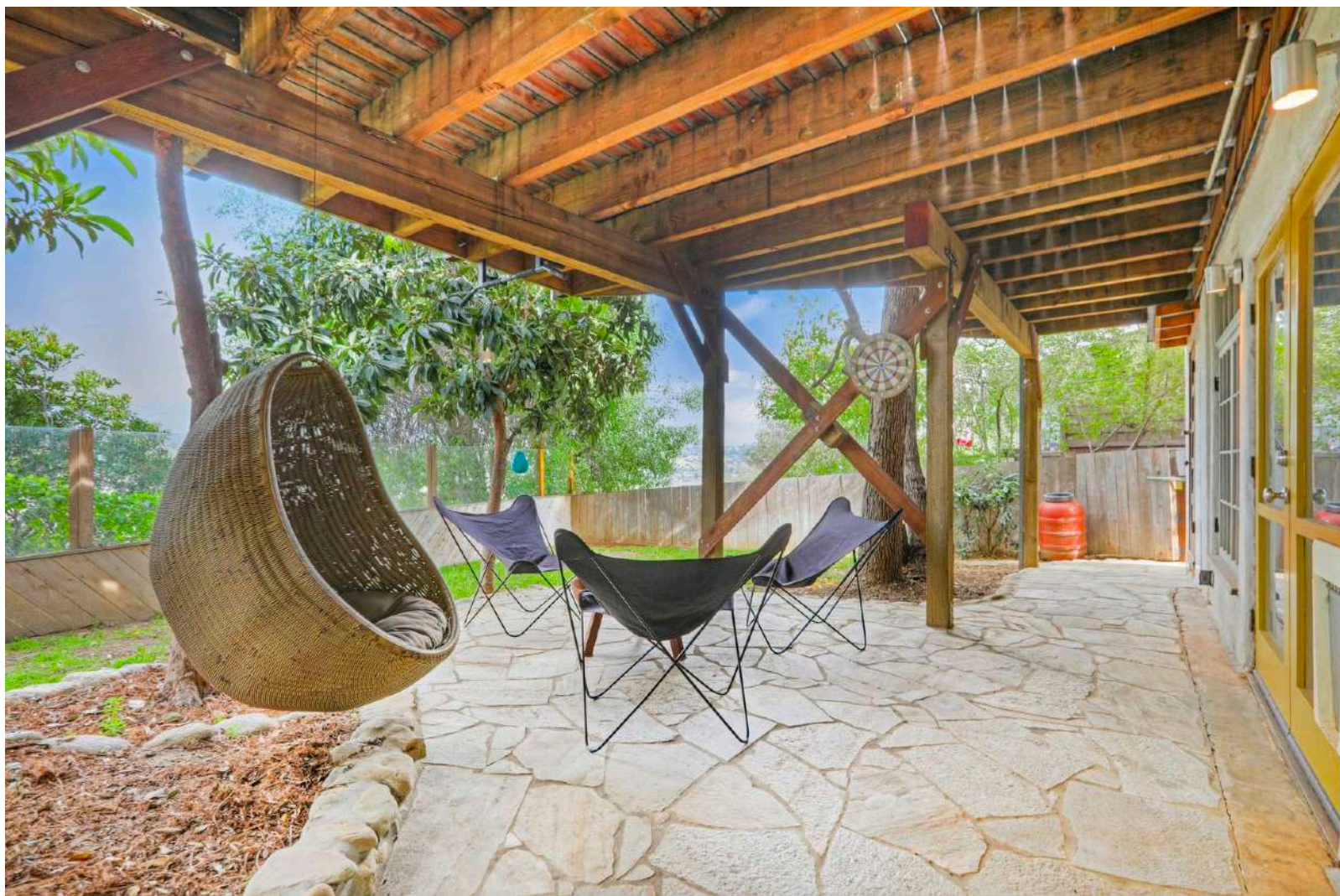
















Measuring 6,428 square feet, the tree-encompassed lot presents a rare city sanctuary.
